

The Goal 6 Committee meeting minutes  
8-21-2015

At 11:20 A.M. Sharon Banks, ADA Coordinator for the city of Raleigh, joined Teresa Staley on the line. While waiting for others to join the teleconference Banks explained her role, i.e., making sure the city is compliant with standards set by the ADA. Staley then began an explanation of the purpose of the Goal 6 Committee and its major objectives. Banks asked that the explanation be held until David Eatman joined the conference. Eatman, Transit Administrator for the city of Raleigh, joined the teleconference at 11:30 am. Staley repeated the Goal 6 Committee purpose and objectives for Eatman, who then recommended that Don Willis, who is with Wake County Human Service Transportation, be contacted to speak. Eatman explained that the program Willis administers for Wake County is similar to SCAT in Greensboro. Staley then asked Banks to clarify how the ADA is enforced through her office. Banks stated there is one coordinator over a staff in the field, which evaluates ADA compliance. Staley stated that this infrastructure intersects with the Goal 6 2nd objectives. Staley then explained the function of the SILC quarterly meetings in Burlington and suggested that Banks, Eatman, and Willis might be excellent as future speakers to the full SILC.
